#### PRE-MASSAGE SESSION INFORMATION

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Canine massage, remedial and complementary therapies are not a substitute for veterinary care.

*These therapies are integrative and in addition to your pet's usual vet care. If you have any concerns about the health of your animals, please always seek advice and a diagnosis from your veterinarian. Only a licensed veterinarian can diagnose a health condition or disease.*

1. Massage should only be done 1hr after/ prior to eating meals.
2. Please toilet your dog/animal before the massage otherwise the massage may be uncomfortable on a full bladder or bowel. If your dog/animal has been vomiting or has diarrhea prior to massage, best to reschedule to another time when they are well and you have taken them to the vet to get checked out.
3. Animals with parasites (e.g. fleas and mites) won't be treated until these are under control and resolved.
4. Animals with open wounds won't be massaged until they have received wound care from your veterinarian, and your veterinarian authorises it is safe for your dog/ animal to receive remedial complementary treatment.
5. Keep water available for your dog during and after the massage

#### PRE-LASER SESSION INFORMATION



**IMPORTANT NOTE:** K-laser (biomodulation) therapy is integrative and in addition to your pets usual vet care. If you have any concerns about the health of your animals, please, always seek advice and a diagnosis from your veterinarian. Only a licensed veterinarian can diagnose a health condition or disease.

### **What is laser therapy?**

Class IV K-laser delivers red and infra-red wavelengths of laser light in order to induce therapeutic effects.

### **Technology**

K-laser combines cutting-edge technology and extensive research in order to offer the best tools for professionals and patients. Different wavelengths are used in various combinations, power, and pulsed frequencies in order to target the body's optimal light absorbing complexes.

### **Therapeutic effects**

The pleasant application of K-laser energy increases blood flow to the affected area, drawing oxygen and nutrients. This creates a great healing environment.

### **Cellular effects**

The K-laser infrared laser beam interacts with tissues at a cellular level stimulating the transfer of nutrients through the cell membrane and accelerating the production of ATP (cellular energy). The result is accelerated healing and reduced pain.

### **Desired therapeutic effects**

- Increase circulation
- Decrease inflammation
- Reduce pain
- Enhance tissue healing
- Improve mobility

### **Benefits of laser therapy**

Class IV laser enhances tissue repair by bio-stimulation. K-laser accelerates the natural healing process of the body by reducing inflammation and pain.

For chronic and acute pain management, Class IV laser often provides great results.

### **How often can a treatment be received?**

- Acute condition: daily
- Chronic condition: 2-3 times a week
- Long term condition: 1-2 times a month

### **How many treatments are necessary?**

Related to the nature of the condition:

- Acute: 1-4 may be enough
- Chronic problems: 5-12 (or more)
- Long term: monthly (arthritis)

### **When do you feel the results?**

Most of the time improvement (pain reduction) is felt after the very first treatment. Sometimes for chronic conditions several treatments are necessary. Treatments are cumulative and results are often felt after 3 to 4 sessions.

### **Is it compatible with other treatments?**

Laser therapy is often applied at the same time as other forms of treatment. It can also be used in post-surgery, rehabilitation, manual therapy, dental care and wound management.

### **What does treatment feel like?**

There is nearly no sensation during treatment. Occasionally a mild warmth can be felt. Painful or inflamed areas can be briefly sensitive before pain reduction occurs.

### **Are there any side effects or risks?**

After 20 years of use by practitioners around the world very few side effects have been reported. On rare occasions some old injuries may feel aggravated for a few hours as the healing process is more active following
